The day for onsite Jules submissions is Monday, October 4, 4 to 6:30 pm

Each GNAL member can submit up to two (2) pieces of their work with a \$25 for two pieces. Canvas wrap art is permitted. The size limit is 16 x 20 including frame.

Included in the Jules Art Exhibit is FREE Social marketing with cross promotion. Artists will enjoy a wider audience and exposure for their art. There will be roughly 1800 people viewing your artwork each week. Take advantage of all the exposure this show will bring to your artwork!

- Open to all artists with up to date GNAL membership
- You may renew or join GNAL here <https://gnal800west.org/membership/>
- You may exhibit previously shown artwork from GNAL shows.
- No frames required, but must be professionally finished work, such as canvas wrap with braided wire on the back. Not accepting any work with sawtooth hangers.
- Artwork may not include gore, nudity, or controversial subjects due to the family oriented nature of the space.
- The Art Show Team reserves the right to refuse entry of artwork if it deems appropriate to do so.

SALES

- 25% commission will be charged on all work sold by members during the show.
- Buyer's check must be made out to the artist. The artist assumes responsibility for payment of proper commission due to GNAL within 10 days of the sale. (GNAL will accept cash or check)

PICK UP

Your work will need to be picked up on Monday January 10, between 4 and 6:30 pm; no exceptions. You may then submit new artwork for the next show.

The October theme will be "Birds". The "Birds" show will run through January 2022. The pick up for the October show is Monday, January 10, between 4 and 6:30 pm; no exceptions. Our next show theme will be "Winter Skies". Stay tuned for more information on more shows. (If you don't have Birds a nature scene will be accepted.)

Unless arrangements are made with GNAL prior to pick up, any artwork that is left at the show will be considered a donation to the art league.

Pricing Your Work

Here are some things to consider when trying to put a price on your art:

- How much time did you spend making it?
- How much did the materials cost that you put into it (canvas, clay, paints, finishes, etc.)?
- How much does it mean to you? Not everything about price comes down to hard costs of time and materials. Sometimes it just has that "wow" factor that means a lot to you or someone else. That's worth something! That's what an artist can do that no one else can and you should value that as best you can in the

price.

Don't forget to include your name, your address, your phone, your email, title of each piece, medium(s) used, and price of each piece. (Without this information we will not know how to contact you.)
